NC-PHRF Meeting Minutes – August 10, 2011 Attendees: Bill Jarvis, Dyk Luben, Harry Preddy, Craig Beavers, Mark Weinheimer, Mark Brennesholtz

- 1. The "acting" treasurer reported that we have about \$5200 in the bank, about \$600 more than at the beginning of the year. In addition, club dues from member clubs have not yet been invoiced. Most of the surplus is due to the Committee meeting less frequently than quarterly. It was resolved that the Committee should meet at least two times per year face to face.
- 2. The Committee considered the appeal by Dave Furna of the rating on a Viper 640 that was rated at 90P. It was unanimous to change the rating to 96P based on performance and other area ratings (excluding Southern California and Charleston where it is likely that they only race one design). Bill J. did an analysis comparing with Melges 24s, and ratings were widely varying across the country. 96 looks more consistent than 90.
- 3. We are requesting feedback on the more generous prop allowances being tested for the first time this year. So far no complaints, but two boats have suggested they might go back from folding to fixed 3 blade next haulout.
